Morning: Proceed to the ancient city of Mtskheta, often called the Second Jerusalem. Visit two
major Christian shrines: o Jvary Monastery o Svetitskhoveli Cathedral (home to the Heaton of
the Lord).
 Afternoon: Visit Gori, an important city on the Silk Road. Explore the Museum of
Joseph Stalin, dedicated to the life of the Soviet leader born in Gori. The museum retains its
Soviet-era characteristics.

The Booking

• Your contract is with Disney Yatra Tours and Travels. A contract exists between us when we have confirmed you for your tour of choice and received your signed booking form and deposits. All the relevant sections must be correctly and fully completed. We can only accept a booking form signed, confirming that you and others on the tour accept our booking terms and conditions and are entering into the contract.

• Deposit: Upon completion of the signed booking form, a deposit of 50% of the tour cost per person must be paid to the company.

• Payments: For all contracted services, a 50% advance payment is required to hold the booking on a confirmed basis, with the balance paid 7 days before your departure. Management personnel hold the right to decide the amount for advance payment based on the nature of the service and the time left before the service commences. For special cases such as Train Journeys, hotels, or resorts during peak seasons (X-Mas, New Year), full payment may be required in advance.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

• All cancellations must be made in writing to us at least a month prior to the arrival date of the client. We levy the following cancellation charges:

Complaints
