Tour Itinerary

Day 1 | Arrival in Amman

- Arrival: Upon arrival at Queen Alia International Airport (QAIA), you will be welcomed by our representative holding a name sign before customs. Assistance will be provided to arrange your free visa.
- Transfer: After collecting your visa and luggage, your driver will transfer you to your hotel in Amman for check-in and overnight stay.

Day 2 | Amman – Jerash – Amman City Tour – Amman

- Breakfast: At your hotel.
- Jerash: After breakfast, travel to Jerash to visit the world's best-preserved Roman provincial city.
- Amman City Tour: After your visit to Jerash, return to Amman for a city tour. Amman was known as Rabbath-Ammon in the Old Testament, and it was the capital of the Ammonites around 1200 BC. Visit key historical sites including:
 - o The Citadel: Offering beautiful views of the city and home to the Temple of Hercules, the Omayyad Palace, and the Byzantine church.
 - o Roman Theatre: Located in downtown Amman.
- Overnight: Stay at your hotel in Amman with bed & breakfast

Day 3 | Amman – Mount Nebo – Madaba – Karak – Petra

- Breakfast: At your hotel.
- Madaba: Depart for Madaba to visit St. George Church and its famous mosaic map.
- Mount Nebo: Continue to Mount Nebo, where Moses is said to have viewed the Promised Land.
- Karak: Travel along the King's Highway to Kerak to visit the Crusader Castle.
- Petra: If time permits, visit Little Petra; otherwise, transfer directly to Petra for check-in at your hotel.
- Overnight: Stay in Petra with bed & breakfast

Day 4 | Petra – Wadi Rum

- Breakfast: At your hotel.
- Petra: Spend the day exploring Petra, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Enter via the Siq and visit key sites such as:
 - o The Treasury
 - o Street of Facades
 - o The Theater
 - o Colonnaded Street
 - o Optionally, visit the Monastery and/or High Place of Sacrifice (both involve some climbing but offer great views).
- Wadi Rum: After your Petra visit, transfer to Wadi Rum for a unique desert experience.
- Overnight: Stay in a desert camp at Wadi Rum with bed & breakfast.

Day 5 | Wadi Rum – Dead Sea

- Breakfast: At your camp.
- Wadi Rum: Before your jeep tour, you may opt for a one-hour camel ride from Wadi Rum Village (optional).
- o Jeep Tour: Embark on a two-hour jeep tour to explore the beautiful desert landscapes. Stop at various sites to walk, scramble, and climb some of the stunning natural rock formations.
- Dead Sea: After the jeep tour, transfer to the Dead Sea. Enjoy the unique experience of floating in the salty waters.
- Overnight: Stay at your hotel by the Dead Sea with bed & breakfast.

Day 6 | Departure

- • Breakfast: At your hotel. • Transfer: Check out of your hotel and transfer to Queen Alia International Airport for your flight back home.

Terms & Conditions

The Booking

- Your contract is with Disney Yatra Tours and Travels. A contract exists between us when we have confirmed you for your tour of choice and received your signed booking form and deposits. All the relevant sections must be correctly and fully completed. We can only accept a booking form signed, confirming that you and others on the tour accept our booking terms and conditions and are entering into the contract.
- Deposit: Upon completion of the signed booking form, a deposit of 50% of the tour cost per person must be paid to the company.
- Payments: For all contracted services, a 50% advance payment is required to hold the booking on a confirmed basis, with the balance paid 7 days before your departure. Management personnel hold the right to decide the amount for advance payment based on the nature of the service and the time left before the service commences. For special cases such as Train Journeys, hotels, or resorts during peak seasons (X-Mas, New Year), full payment may be required in advance.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- All cancellations must be made in writing to us at least a month prior to the arrival date of the client. We levy the following cancellation charges:

Complaints regarding services should be communicated to Disney Yatra Tours and Travels during the tour. Refunds, if any, will be made in Indian Rupees only and processed before departure at the end of the tour as per the conversion rate at the time of refund.
- In case of legal disputes, jurisdiction will be in Jaipur City, India. Refunds for unused services or shortened tours due to genuine reasons will be executed within 10 days after your return to your home country.

Complaints

Passports & Visas

- To travel to India from overseas countries (except for Nepal & Bhutan citizens), a valid passport with 6 months' validity and a visa are required. The processing of the passport and visa is not included in the tour cost.

Early Check-in / Late Check-out

- Standard check-in/check-out times in most hotels are 1200 hrs (IST). Therefore, the cost of early check-in or late check-out is not included in the tour cost. Requests for early check-in or late check-out will be made but are not guaranteed and depend on the hotel policy and room

availability.
