The Booking

- Your contract is with Disney Yatra Tours and Travels. A contract exists between us when we have confirmed you for your tour of choice and received your signed booking form and deposits. We can only accept a booking form signed, confirming that you and others on the tour accept our booking terms and conditions and are entering into the contract.
- Deposit: Upon completion of the signed booking form, a deposit of 50% of the tour cost per person must be paid to the company.
- Payments: For all contracted services, a 50% advance payment is required to hold the booking on a confirmed basis, with the balance paid 7 days before your departure. Management personnel hold the right to decide the amount for advance payment based on the nature of the service and the time left before the service commences. For special cases such as Train Journeys, hotels, or resorts during peak seasons (X-Mas, New Year), full payment may be required in advance.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

• All cancellations must be made in writing to us at least a month prior to the arrival date of the client. We levy the following cancellation charges:
