Tour Itinerary

Day 1 | Arrival in Muscat

- Arrive at Muscat International Airport. • After immigration clearance, baggage collection, and customs, proceed to the arrival hall to meet your chauffeur. • Transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Day 2 | Muscat City Tour

- Morning: o Half-day city tour of Muscat. o Visit the Grand Mosque and Bait Al Zubair Museum. o Drive along the waterfront Corniche and visit the colorful Muttrah Souq. o Photo stop at the magnificent Al Alam Palace, the official palace of His Majesty Sultan Qaboos, flanked by the 16th-century Portuguese forts Mirani & Jalali. • Meals: Breakfast at the hotel.

Day 3 | Dolphin Watching

- Morning: o Transfer from the hotel to the Marina for a thrilling dolphin and whale-watching excursion. o Explore the seas around Muscat, where you may spot wild dolphins and possibly some whale species. • Afternoon: o Return to the Marina and transfer back to the hotel. o Rest of the day at leisure to explore the city or enjoy the hotel facilities. • Meals: Breakfast at the hotel

Day 4 | Muscat - Nizwa - Jabal Akhdar

- Morning: o Transfer to Nizwa, the capital of the interior and birthplace of Islam in Oman. o Visit the famous Round Tower Fort (photo stop), built in the 17th century. o Explore the Nizwa Souq, renowned for its Friday cattle auction, intricately hand-carved Khanjars (daggers), and ornamental silver jewelry. o Proceed to Wadi Al Madeen, where a check post is located. o Continue on a winding 36 km stretch of road leading to Jebel Akhdar, a green jewel in the Al Hajjar mountain ranges (2,000 meters above sea level).
- Evening: o Enjoy the cool mountain climate. o Overnight stay at Sama Jabal Akhdar Hotel.
- Meals: Breakfast and Dinner at the hotel.

Day 5 | Jabal Akhdar Exploration & Departure

- Morning: o Explore the famed fruit orchards of Al Jebel Al Akhdar, terraced along the mountain slopes, fed by natural springs and aflaj. o Visit the villages of Saiq, Wadi Bani Habib (the village of old houses), and others like Al Ain. o Enjoy the spectacular views of dramatic peaks, gorges, and wadis. o In spring (March/April), the roses of Jabal Akhdar fill the air with fragrance. Rose water is distilled in the local homes. o Wear light, comfortable clothing and walking shoes for the excursion.
- Afternoon: o Transfer back to Muscat and proceed to Muscat International Airport for your departure.
- Meals: Breakfast at the hotel

What is generally the size of a tour group ?

Terms & Conditions

The Booking

- Your contract is with Disney Yatra Tours and Travels. A contract exists between us when we have confirmed you for your tour of choice and received your signed booking form and deposits. All the relevant sections must be correctly and fully completed. We can only accept a booking form signed, confirming that you and others on the tour accept our booking terms and conditions and are entering into the contract.
- Deposit: Upon completion of the signed booking form, a deposit of 50% of the tour cost per person must be paid to the company.
- Payments: For all contracted services, a 50% advance payment is required to hold the booking on a confirmed basis, with the balance paid 7 days before your departure. Management personnel hold the right to decide the amount for advance payment based on the nature of the service and the time left before the service commences. For special cases such as Train Journeys, hotels, or resorts during peak seasons (X-Mas, New Year), full payment may be required in advance.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

- All cancellations must be made in writing to us at least a month prior to the arrival date of the client. We levy the following cancellation charges:
