Day 1 | Arrival in Varanasi & Evening Ganga Aarti

 Arrival: Pick up from Varanasi Airport/Railway Station and transfer to your hotel.
Check-in: Freshen up at the hotel.
Evening: Visit the Ganga Aarti at the ghats of Varanasi. Witness the stunning, spiritual ceremony held by priests on the banks of the river.
Overnight: Stay at Varanasi

Day 2 | Varanasi Local Sightseeing

Early Morning: Boat ride on the River Ganges to witness the sunrise and the vibrant activities along the ghats.
Visit: o Vishwanath Temple – dedicated to Lord Shiva, one of the most sacred temples in India. o Gyanvapi Mosque – a historical mosque located near the Vishwanath Temple. o Sankatmochan Hanuman Temple – a revered temple dedicated to Lord Hanuman. o Tulsi Manas Temple – dedicated to Lord Ram, where the epic Ramayana was written.
After Breakfast: Proceed to Sarnath (12 km from Varanasi), where Lord Buddha gave his first sermon after attaining enlightenment. o Visit: ? Dhamekh Stupa – one of the most revered Buddhist shrines in the world.
Sarnath Museum – housing several important Buddhist artifacts.
Evening: Return to your hotel in Varanasi for an overnight stay.

Day 3 | Varanasi to Chitrakoot (250 km / 6.5 hours)

 After Breakfast: Drive to Chitrakoot, a town known for its significance in Hindu mythology.
Check-in: Hotel and freshen up.
Sightseeing: o Bharat Milap Sthal – the site where Bharat met Lord Ram during his exile. o Kamadgiri Parvat – a sacred hill associated with Lord Ram. o Parikrama – a circumambulation around the hill. o Sati Anusuiya Ashram – the ashram of the sage Anusuiya. o Sita Rasoi – a temple dedicated to Lord Ram's wife, Sita.
Overnight: Stay at Chitrakoot. Meals: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

Day 4 | Chitrakoot to Prayagraj (130 km / 4 hours)

 After Breakfast: Drive to Prayagraj (formerly Allahabad).
Check-in: Hotel and freshen up.
Sightseeing: o Sangam – the confluence of the Ganges, Yamuna, and Saraswati rivers. o Lying Hanuman Temple – where Hanuman is depicted reclining. o Anand Bhavan Museum – the ancestral home of Jawaharlal Nehru. o Allahabad Fort – a historic fort built by Emperor Akbar. o Khusro Bagh – the tomb of the Mughal prince Khusro.

Day 5 | Prayagraj to Ayodhya (180 km / 5 hours)

• After Breakfast: Drive to Ayodhya, a city of great religious importance. • Check-in: Hotel and freshen up. • Sightseeing: o Ram Janmabhoomi – the birthplace of Lord Ram. o Hanumangarhi

a temple dedicated to Lord Hanuman. o Kanak Bhavan Temple – a revered temple dedicated to Lord Ram and Sita. o Treta ke Thakur – the place where Lord Ram performed the Ashwamedha Yagya. o Dashrath Mahal – the palace of King Dashrath, Lord Ram's father.
Overnight: Stay at Ayodhya

Day 6 | Departure from Ayodhya

After Breakfast: Check out from the hotel and transfer to Ayodhya Airport/Railway Station.

The Booking

• Deposit: Upon completion of the signed booking form, a deposit of 50% of the tour cost per person must be paid to the company.

• Payments: For all contracted services, a 50% advance payment is required to hold the

booking on a confirmed basis, with the balance paid 7 days before your departure. Management personnel hold the right to decide the amount for advance payment based on the nature of the service and the time left before the service commences. For special cases such as Train Journeys, hotels, or resorts during peak seasons (X-Mas, New Year), full payment may be required in advance.

Cancellation and Refund Policy

• All cancellations must be made in writing to us at least a month prior to the arrival date of the client. We levy the following cancellation charges:
